Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or examination recognized as equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology / Mathematics /Biotechnology / Computer Science separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Mathematics/Biotechnology/Computer Science put together are eligible. Candidate from National Open School are eligible to apply for the course.

## AGE

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on 31.12.2020. Copy of relevant page of school record namely SSLC/CBSE/ICSE certificates showing the date of birth/copy of the birth certificate from appropriate authority should be furnished along with the application attested by the Gazetted Officer/ Head of the Institution where the student had last studied.

## **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

Admissions will be done on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying examinations as mentioned below.

The mark obtained by the candidates in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or authority of other States shall be equated with the mark obtained by the candidates in the same subject in the qualifying examination conducted by the Director of HSE, Kerala. Marks obtained by the candidates under various streams of examinations such as HSE in Kerala/ CBSE/ICSE etc. will be subject to the process of normalization. Selection will be based on rank list prepared from the applications received.

## **PUBLICATION OF RANK LIST**

Admission will be made on the basis of the applications received through online.

1. In the case of a tie in the total marks, the marks in Chemistry in the qualifying examination will be counted. If there is still a tie, the marks in Physics will be counted. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken in to account, the elder preferred to the younger. If a tie again exists, the alphabetical ascending order of the name of the candidates in English will be taken in to account.

2. Furnishing false information/ particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

3. Seats lying vacant after the date fixed for the completion of admission will be treated as lapsed seats and can be filled up by the College among the application received from the eligible candidates.

## **ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING FOR EXAMINATIONS**

### 1. Attendance, progress and condonation option

A candidate should secure 80% attendance in theory and practical subjects separately to appear for university examination. Only students with 70% and above attendance are eligible for condonation. Condonation for shortage of attendance shall be vested with a committee constituted by the Principal/ Head of the respective college as the Chairman and five members (senior teachers) in the committee. The benefit of condonation will be available to the students only once during the entire course.

### 2. A candidate is eligible for registering for the examination only if he/she secures a minimum of 50% in mark in internal assessment in theory and practical separately.

3. Partial appearance for the examination: A candidate is allowed partial appearance for the University/Board examinations provided he/she has minimum 80%(B. Pharm) attendance in all subjects, in theory and practical separately.

## **COURSE OUTLINE**

The B.Pharm course is of four years duration, with University examinations at the end of each year and includes one month internship/practical training and industrial visit.

## **INDUSTRIAL VISIT**

Students of fourth B Pharm course should visit some pharmaceutical manufacturing units or national research laboratories as a supplement to the academic training and submit a report to the satisfaction of the Head of institution.

## **GENERAL DISCIPLINE**

1. Students should be regular and punctual in the classes.
2. Students shall avail; only ten days of leave on medical grounds in an academic year that should compensate.
3. The students shall strictly follow the existing rules and regulations as well as the same implemented by the Institution from time to time.
4. Ragging is strictly prohibited. If anybody encourage or involved in ragging, will be attract disciplinary actions without any excuse. Further they will be prosecuted as per the existing law.
5. Students should refrain from defacing and damaging college property.
6. In case of breakage /loss of college property they shall be made good promptly, either individually or collectively.
7. The management has the right to take disciplinary actions on any student whose conduct and character are not satisfactory.
8. Students must be regular and punctual in lectures demonstrations, seminars, practical, field work and such academic exercises. They are required to attend all the allotted working periods in each of the prescribed subjects. If so recommended by the respective Head of departments the principal is permitted under the regulations of

university to countdown shortage of class attendance up to 10% caused by illness and such other valid reasons.

## **PROHIBITION OF RAGGING**

Ragging within or outside the institution is strictly prohibited. Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside the college will be liable for strict action as per the provision of prohibition of ragging in Educational Institution Act 26 of 1997.
